After an initial set-up fee, a modest annual subscription is payable which includes:

- · continuous use of www.lostdogsuk.co.uk for displaying dogs found by your authority
- all information sheet creation
- uploading information 7 days a week
- all background administration involved in . operating the website
- undertaking any changes to the tailored information sheet
- all IT costs involved in operating the service

Your authority can choose one of two levels of annual subscription based on anticipated usage

- Up to 100 published dogs per annum found within your authority
- Unlimited number of dogs per annum found within your authority

COMMITMENT TO ANIMAL WELFARE

SDK Environmental is one of the principal providers of animal services in the South of England with over forty local authorities as clients across its three main divisions. Our Animal Welfare Officers collect found dogs on behalf of many local authorities in the South of England, seven days a week, twenty four hours a day. Dogs collected during the day are taken directly to councils nominated kennel providers in specially adapted vehicles. To reduce the stress, dogs collected out of hours are held overnight at our modern, secure, hygienic and air conditioned holding unit and then transported to the nominated kennels the next day. Amongst its key principles, SDK is committed to

OBJECTIVES AND BENEFITS

SDK's lost dog website, www.lostdoguk.co.uk, provides 24/7 access to the public in order to match owners to their lost dogs. It allows the general public to browse the dogs we have found and collected at their convenience and without being limited by the opening and closing times of departments and organisations. As a result, dogs are re-united with owners more readily and re-homing opportunities increased. It also

- provides an easy point of reference for support services to refer the public to so that they can check if the dog collected belongs to them
- enables easy-to-access, downloadable details of the found dog in pdf format for the public to study
- eliminates doubt from any callers mind by providing clear pictures of the dogs
- helps improve customer service
- reduces call times and eliminates repetition
- publicises a dog even if it has strayed or been taken to other council area
- increasingly the public are contacting us to offer potential homes to strays thus improving re-homing opportunities
- caters for all sections of communities and provides translation capabilities

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Being cloud-based, the www.lostdogsuk.co.uk is accessible via the internet and is available 24/7. Information comes from two primary sources:

SDK Animal Wardens from areas where we are contracted to operate From the subscribing local authority via details sent through secure e-mail for loading onto the website

On receipt of the found dogs details, SDK populates a tailored information sheet with the dogs details and pictures, along with specific information in the event of it being collected.

The finalised information sheet is normally uploaded within 24 hours of receipt, all part of the annual subscription fee.

The Found Dog Information Sheet is tailored specifically to your authority giving clear details about the animal and transparent instructions regarding collection times and fees.

It acts as a definitive source of information and provides the public with all necessary information.

Uncollected dogs are displayed for be displayed for the statutory detention period applying to councils before automatically dropping from public view.

The details are held in the background database for a longer period.

Dogs collected by their owners are marked as 'RE-UNITED' and stay visible to the public for 14 days whilst any dogs collected by another member of the public remain visible for 30 days before being taken down from the website.

With all the administration undertaken by SDK, all your authority has to do is send details of the found dog and let us know if it has been collected by its owner or another member of the public.
